

**SEIBU FREE Wi-Fi service will be provided  
inside the Red Arrow Limited Express**

**Implementation to start in stages from September 2016**

Seibu Railway Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Tokorozawa City, Saitama Prefecture, President: Hisashi Wakabayashi, hereinafter “Seibu Railway”) and NTT Broadband Platform, Inc. (Head Office: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo, President: Natsuo Minamikawa, hereinafter “NTTBP”) are jointly offering the SEIBU FREE Wi-Fi service, a free public wireless LAN (hereinafter “Free Wi-Fi”) service to overseas travelers in Japan. This service is currently provided inside 23 stations. To further improve customer convenience, all cars of the Red Arrow Limited Express will adopt the SEIBU FREE Wi-Fi service with staged implementation starting from September 2016. Among Seibu Railway cars, the Red Arrow Limited Express (10000 series) will be the first train to provide the Free Wi-Fi service.

Seibu Railway will continue to make efforts to attract overseas visitors in Japan by enhancing the Internet environment and actively offering both hardware and software services.

**\*SEIBU FREE Wi-Fi**

Customers can easily connect to the Internet from their smartphones or other communication devices within the Wi-Fi areas simply by registering their mail addresses on the dedicated SEIBU FREE Wi-Fi website, which is available in six languages (English, Chinese [traditional Chinese characters and simplified Chinese characters], Thai, Korean, and Japanese).

This service is offered through participation in Japan Connected-free Wi-Fi, which NTTBP supplies as a free Wi-Fi area search and connection application program targeted at overseas visitors. Just one registration with Japan Connected-free Wi-Fi enables users to access the Internet in other areas serviced by NTTBP, in addition to service areas provided by SEIBU FREE Wi-Fi.

Ikebukuro, Seibu-shinjuku, Takadanobaba, Tokorozawa, Seibu-kyujo-mae, Hon-kawagoe, Seibu-chichibu, Nerima, Shakujii-koen, Oizumi-gakuen, Hibarigaoka, Akitsu, Irumashi, Hanno, Toshimaen, Saginomiya, Kami-shakujii, Tanashi, Kodaira, Higashi-murayama, Sayamashi, Haijima, and Kokubunji.
6. Japan Connected-free Wi-Fi (Japan Wi-Fi)  
SEIBU FREE Wi-Fi participates in the certified application, Japan Wi-Fi supplied by NTTBP. Accordingly, with just one Japan Wi-Fi customer registration, in addition to areas serviced by SEIBU FREE Wi-Fi, users can get free Wi-Fi services with simple connection procedures in other areas (about 145,000 access points<sup>\*1</sup> including major airports, large stations, and tourist spots nationwide) which participate in Japan Wi-Fi<sup>\*2</sup>.
